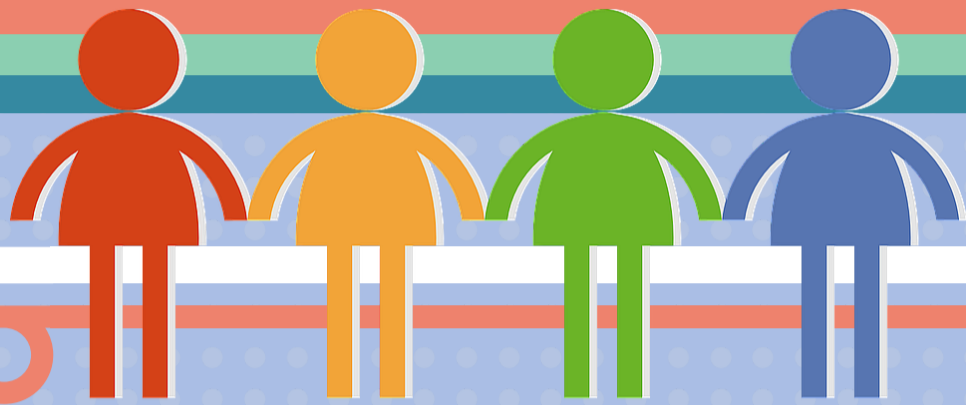

Agile starts with a Coach, called a ScrumMaster. Your ScrumMaster leads the team and all Agile Best Practices



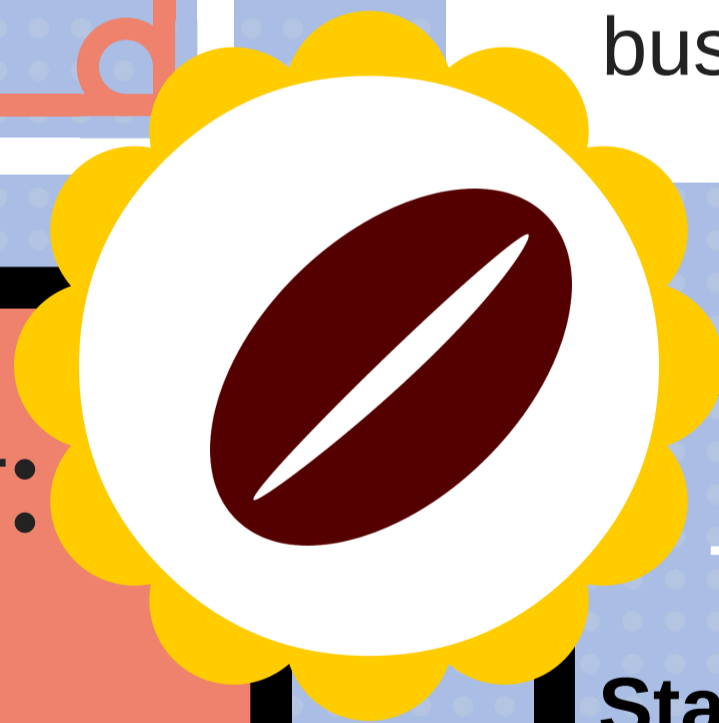
The Agile Team

Agile Best Practices

Progress via working software
Collaboration trumps status meetings
Work at a sustainable pace
Flex on scope, not schedule
Foster strong technical excellence.
Keep the team small.
Time box your work.
Work from a prioritized backlog.
Humanize everyone, the devs, the business, we're all in it together.

Terminology:

ScrumMaster: Team Coach
Backlog: Prioritized list of work
Story: Agile user requirement.
Grooming: Prioritizing work and verifying requirements.
Story points: estimated score of effort and complexity of a story.
Velocity: Average sum of story points completed in an iteration



Agile Ceremonies

Standup: Daily team check-in
Iteration Review: Demonstration of completed work
Retrospective: Identify what's slowing the team down, and fix it.
Iteration Planning: Planning the work for the iteration. Story review and capacity planning.
